REQUIREMENTS FOR A MINOR IN AGRONOMY

The College of Agriculture and Life Sciences requires a grade of **C or better** in any course used to fulfill the requirements of a minor.

Procedure to declare a minor:

1. Alert your major department that you desire to obtain a minor.
2. Visit with an advisor in the department with which you desire to obtain a minor to obtain information and requirements on the minor. Ask the minor department to accept you in the minor program.
3. Return to your major department and indicate that you have been accepted by the minor department. The major advisor will make your acceptance official.
