Requirements for a Minor in Agronomy

The College of Agriculture and Life Sciences requires a grade of **C or better** in any course used to fulfill the requirements of a minor.

The following courses are required: SCSC 105 or SCSC 205 and SCSC 301

An additional eight (8) hours must be taken from the following courses:

Crops:

SCSC 304 – spring
SCSC 307
SCSC 309 – spring
SCSC 310 – spring
SCSC 311 – fall
SCSC 402 – fall
SCSC 410 – spring
SCSC 444 – spring
SCSC 446 – fall

Soil/Water:

SCSC 401 – fall
SCSC 405
SCSC 406 – lab only
SCSC 422 – fall
SCSC 432 – fall lab only
SCSC 455 – spring
SCSC 458 - spring

Turf:

SCSC-302
SCSC 312 – fall
SCSC 427 – spring odd yrs
SCSC 428 – spring
SCSC 429 – spring
SCSC 430 – spring even yrs

Procedure to declare a minor:

1. Alert your major department that you desire to obtain a minor
2. Visit with an advisor in the Soil and Crop Sciences department to obtain information and requirements on the minor. Ask to be accepted into the SCSC minor program.
3. Return to your major department and indicate that you have been accepted for a minor in the Soil and Crops Sciences department. Your major advisor will make your acceptance official.
